

- **2.** Always, always, call if your child will not be at Cotillion. Give us as much notice as possible. It is very important for our boy-girl ratio. It also helps us to start on-time, so we are not delaying for members who are not coming.
- 3. Please read and cooperate with our "Drop off and Pick up" policies.
- 4. If your child has missed Cotillion, please call us and let us know if you intend to bring them to the Monday make up class. This class is only held on the Mondays that follow cotillion events, from 4-5 pm. If it is impossible to make up on Monday, and your child needs help, call us, we will try to help them at another time. 
Personal Items


Gloves


Girls must wear gloves to all cotillion events.
